The seminar is aimed at all interested referees and judges who already hold a license or have sufficient practical experience as a boxing official.

Referees from all associations are invited to use this seminar for the recognition of their license by the GNBA e.V. and the International Boxing Association IBA.

The course will be led by experienced officials from the IBA. Upon successful participation, attendees will be awarded an international IBA referee license.

The number of participants is limited. Participation will be granted based on the order of registration!
- Instructor: Technical commission of the International Boxing Association (IBA).

- Participation fee: €250 for GNBA members / €400 for participants from foreign associations.
Participants will receive a certificate and confirmation of participation.
Accommodation and meals are the responsibility of the participants.
- Schedule: Sept. 25th & 26th Theoretical lessons with a written final exam
Sept. 27th Practical training and scenarios
Sept. 28th & 29th The final evaluation with a practical test will take place during the international boxing tournament "Viking Cup." Participants will act as referees and judges during the tournament. Supervision, guidance and evaluation will be provided by the IBA training team.
- Please bring: A notebook, writing utensils, and official clothing for referees and judges (black pants, white shirt, black shoes).
- Data Protection: During the entire event, photo and video recordings may be made, in which participants may appear. By registering, each participant consents to the use of these recordings by the organizer and participating clubs for public relations, press work, and illustrations. The recordings will be stored digitally.
